REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL SUMMER STUDENTS:

To be considered for summer student employment with Synergy North, students must have been attending school on a full-time basis for the 2018-19 school year, and be returning to full-time studies for the 2019-20 school year.

ASSET MANAGEMENT & ENGINEERING (GIS)

Qualifications:

- Enrolled in a post-secondary program (diploma or degree) and returning as a full-time student in the fall of 2019.
- Completion of an Introductory GIS course (or equivalent)
- Knowledge and Experience with ESRI GIS Mapping software
- Knowledge and Experience of Windows and Microsoft Office software.
- Valid Ontario Driver's license (Class G) with an excellent driving record and ability to pass the driver's proficiency test (as performed by a third party).
- Must be self-motivated and a quick learner.
- Able to work independently and in a team environment.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience in a Utility or Industrial environment.
- Experience reading electrical schematics.
- Database application programming (MS Access, SQL, etc.).

General Duties:

- Carryout independent projects (note that the size and complexity will depend on the skill, knowledge and initiative of the student).
- Assist GIS Technician with day to day activities and projects.
- Assist in asset data collection and GIS input related tasks.
- Assist in maintaining document storage and updating (including electrical drawings etc.).
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
