POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the general direction of a Supervisor and / or assigned staff member is responsible for work assigned to work with Powerline crews or Operations staff in a safe and efficient manner within the utility's service area. Duties & Responsibilities:

- Assist the labour crew in installing duct work and/or trenching.
- Assist the Powerline or Station Maintenance crews, as required.
- Hand digging while working around other utilities.
- Use chain saw, fork lift, and/or operate gas powered tools or equipment.
- Traffic control/flagging for crews.
- Clean up of Synergy North construction sites, Operations Centre yard, and/or complete maintenance work on any other Synergy North properties
- Painting (both inside and outside).
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum Grade 12 Secondary School Graduation Diploma, or equivalent.
- Valid Ontario Driver's License with an excellent driving record. *Note: A Driver's Abstract will be processed by SYNERGY NORTH to verify that the applicant has no more than 6 demerit points.*
- Must have a proven mechanical aptitude.
- Must have good reading comprehension and communication skills (written and verbal).
- High regard for personal and public safety in a team setting.
- Must have good customer relations, interpersonal skills and teamwork skills with a commitment to continuous improvement.

PREFERRED:

- Minimum three (3) years of experience as a Labourer.
- Current certification in First Aid, CPR, and WHMIS.
